Series: Hotel or Hospital?

A true follower of Jesus is not nearly as afraid of missing out on this life as they are of their friends missing out on the next one. This Sunday we walked through how to more effectively use what we call the heartbeat of our church: The Corner Card.

Weekly Devotional:

5/3 - Mark 5:1-8, 18-20 - The man wanted to go with Jesus after he had been healed by Jesus and did not want to miss out. Is there any aspect of your walk with God, your calling, purpose, promises, etc that you ever fear you will miss out on?

5/4 - 2 Peter 3:8-13 - Peter tells us that Jesus is "patient" to come again on behalf of those who do not believe in him yet as Lord and Savior. Write down some names of anyone on your heart today that you believe Jesus is being patient for to believe in him. Pray for them.

5/5 - 1 Timothy 1:8-14 - We are encouraged here over and over again to not be ashamed of our testimony of what Jesus has done for us. What is most "scary" for you in sharing Jesus with others?

5/6 - Romans 12:3-8 - God has given each of us gifts to serve and invest in others. Write down some gifts you believe God has given you for the purpose of building up others.

5/7 - 1 Peter 4:7-11 - Peter here encourages us to use our gifts to serve and invest in others. Write down 3 names of people God has called you to serve. Next to their name, write how you can begin to "invest" in each of them.

Challenge:

Grab a Card. Change Your World. Begin to utilize the Corner Card on a daily/weekly basis or recommit to it by starting with daily prayer for even 2-3 minutes each morning.
