Series: Every Corner

We believe revival is something God wants to bring to everybody's life. Through the way Jesus lived and the example He set for us, He shows us that our lives are not about what we accomplish but who we impact. In the story of Jesus healing the demoniac, He gives us the recipe for revival and proves how nobody is ever too far gone to experience revival in their own life and then share it with those around them.

Weekly Devotional:

9/6 - Colossians 3:23 - Everyday is an opportunity to do a work that lasts for all of eternity. When it come to the relationships you have with "your people" (8-10 people you do life with regularly) how is God leading you to work heartily for Him in these relationships?

9/7 - Mark 5:1-13 - Jesus went out of his way to bring light to the darkest of places. What is an area or relationships in your life that you have been hesitant to go to because they seem too far gone for God to reach. How is God leading you to bring his light there?

9/8 - Mark 5:14-17 - The people of this area of the Decapolis begged Jesus to leave. If Jesus experienced rejection in sharing His light with the world, then we will too. Have you ever experienced rejection in sharing your faith? If so, how did God lead you through it? If not, do you think you are sharing it enough?

9/9 - Mark 5:18-20 - Jesus gives us his recipe for revival in his command to this man. 1. Go to your people. 2. Remember what God has done for you 3. Have something worth giving away (your testimony). Of these three ingredients, which do you feel God is asking you to grow in? How is He leading you to do this?

9/10 - Mark 7:31-Mark 8:8 - When Jesus saved the demonic the people in the Decapolis rejected Jesus. And we see that just a few chapters later, this same area can't get enough of Jesus. The difference? This man sharing what God did for him. Some people may not be ok with Jesus until they see Jesus in you. How can you help others see Jesus through the way you live?

Challenge: Write out your testimony. Use the three parts below as a guide:

1. Life before Jesus
2. An encounter with God
3. New Life with Jesus
